WEEKLY REFLECTION

Have you ever resented someone who, in your view, did not appear to be "pulling their weight?" That is how Martha felt as she was tending to the hospitality needs while her sister was sitting and talking with Jesus. She expected Jesus to tell Mary to get busy, but instead Jesus gently rebuked her! The point is not really who was doing the "right" thing – they were both doing what they were called to do. Martha's problem was that she wanted everyone to do as she did. It is easy to resent others for not having our priorities, but it is not our job to tell others what they should do. Our concern should be on what we are doing. Are we tending to those things we have been called to do? **Read Luke 10:41**
