## CORPUS CHRISTI RETREAT CENTER SHINGLETOWN, CA

As you know, the North State has been in need of a place for parishes, religious organizations and faith-based groups to meet for prayer, education, reflection and faith formation. We now have that place located on 17 acres in beautiful Shingletown, California.

At present, the facilities consist of Mary, Queen of Peace Catholic Church, which shares the 17 acre property with CCRC. The church seats 125 people and there are restroom facilities for both men and women. A kitchen is available which is equipped with a refrigerator, microwave, stove and oven. There is also a small meeting room off the main entry hall. A picnic area has been developed on the north side of the church consisting of 3 concrete benches on a concrete patio.

A monthly First Friday Mass at 4:00pm will be celebrated for all the benefactors of Corpus Christi Retreat Center at Mary, Queen of Peace Church in Shingletown. The church is located at Shingletown Ridge Road and Highway 44. Please join us for Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Confessions are available 15 minutes before Mass.

We are in the process of soliciting donations for memorials. These include:

† Stations of the Cross – each station consists of a six foot rugged wood cross. On each cross is mounted a depiction of one of the 14 stations. Donation: \$200 per station. (To be erected in September 2007).

† Outdoor bench for each Station of the Cross, Our Lady of the Smile outdoor chapel and for rest stops on trails that wander through the retreat center. Donation: \$500 per bench.

† Renovation of Our Lady of the Smile outdoor chapel. A \$25,000 donation will cover the new roof, concrete floor and lighting.

† Altar, Ambo and Presider's Chair for the outdoor chapel. Donation: \$15,000.
