What's new in Natural Family Planning may surprise you? Did you know that the Creighton Model/Fertility Care Services is part of a whole new branch of reproductive medicine called NaPro Technology? The same chart used by a woman to record her observations of the fertile phase within her menstrual cycle can also be used as a diagnostic tool by physicians trained in this discipline to identify and treat infertility and gynecological abnormalities. A safe, effective, and inexpensive form of family planning, it also assists women in monitoring, evaluating, and maintaining their health.
