"I lay down my life in order to take it up again." (John 10:16)

Our Lord's words above seem to roll Lent, Holy Week, the Triduum and Easter into one. Regarding the sacrifice of His life, Jesus makes it clear that this sacrifice is free and *intentional*, "No one takes it (His life) from me, but I lay it down on my own." Jesus' death for the salvation of all is no accident, but a willful, free, total and intentional gift of self for all.

Jesus grants us the gift and opportunity of salvation through the free and intentional sacrifice of His life, and He calls us to walk in love – sacrificial, willful, intentional, self-donating love. While we cannot say, "I lay my life down in order to take it up," we can, and should, by His graces, offer our lives in service to Him, our families and neighbors, and trust that we may have a resurrection like His. Let us make this total offering of ourselves with burning evangelistic zeal in the hope of the resurrection to eternal life.
